Registration fee is **\$150** and is in addition to the camp tuition fee of **\$600.00**.

Registration Fee. The Registration fee of **\$150** covers camp supplies, photo session, **one (1) camp t-shirt and one (1) Performance t-shirt.**

Extra camp t-shirts are **\$15.00** each.

Paid registration fees are non-refundable.

Tuition Fee. Tuition fee of **\$600** is due in full by **May 1st**. **Registration will be closed once we reach the maximum number of campers that have paid in full.**

Early Bird Discount – Tuition is **\$550** if paid by **April 17, 2026**.

Late Pick-up Fee. Camp ends at 3:00 p.m. daily. There is an additional \$1.00 per minute charge for late pick-up unless you have made aftercare arrangements with the camp. Aftercare fees are \$15.00 a day or \$50.00 for the week per camper and all campers in aftercare must be picked up no later than 4:30 p.m. All other campers must be picked up by 3:00 p.m.

Returned Check Fee. All checks returned due to insufficient funds will be charged \$35.00 and must be exchanged with cash, money order or debit card payment.
